BYLAW NO. 51

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A BASE TAX

Bylaw No. 50, passed May 19th, 2020, being a Bylaw to Provide for a Base Tax is hereby repealed.

The Council of the Resort Village of B-Say-Tah in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as the “Base Tax Bylaw”.
- 2. A base tax shall apply to the types and classifications of property included in the table below:

Property Class	Type of Property		
	Land	OR	Land & Improvements
Residential	\$800.00		\$800.00
Commercial	\$800.00		\$800.00

- 3. Where two or more parcels of land are adjacent and owned by the same person, the assessor shall combine the assessment of those parcels into a single assessment for the purposes of the assessment roll.
